Speech is a spoken expression of ideas and opinions whereas elocution is the manner of delivering the speech.

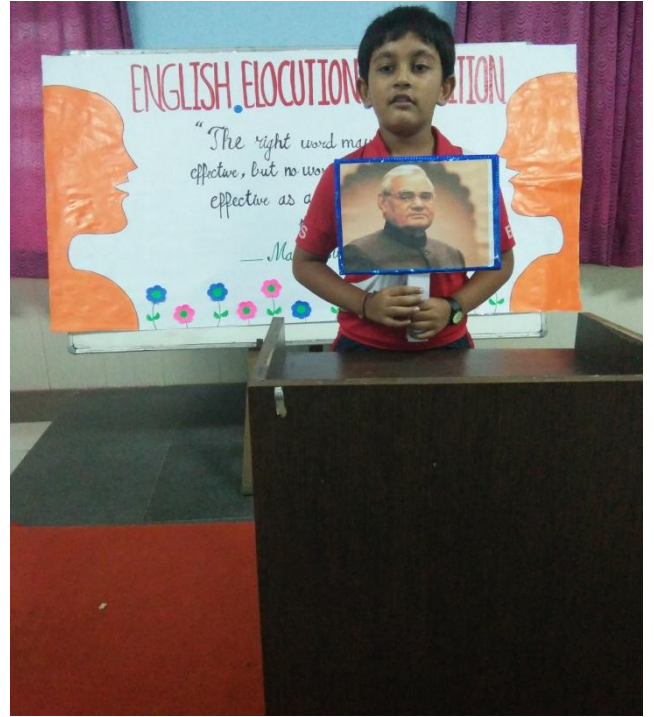
The term elocution is mainly used in reference to a speakers' manner of speech when speaking or reading aloud in public. It is an effective and socially acceptable way of speaking.
